

COMPOSITE SCORE SUMMARY (AIM)

Below is a list of Park Tudor's composite scores on the 2020-2021 Assessment of Inclusivity and Multiculturalism (AIM). Scores are divided into constituent groups.



- The “NAIS Composite Score” is the average composite score based on the number of schools that have completed the AIM survey from 2007 to present (300 schools).

High Priority Concern: a composite score of 3.49 or lower. These issues should be addressed as soon as possible.

Priority Concern: a composite score between 3.50 – 3.99. These issues are not considered immediately critical but need improvement and should be addressed in future plans and initiatives.

Healthy: a composite score of 4.0 and higher. These are issues on which your school is doing comparatively well but where programs and initiatives should be continued or expanded to provide support.
